WHO ARE WE?

The Young Carers Service is a free and friendly service, offering support to young people aged 7-25, caring for someone with a physical disability, mental health issue, long-term physical illness, learning difficulty or for drug and alcohol dependency.

WHAT DO WE DO?

We offer a wide range of services to support young carers, including:

- Assessment
- Respite (trips, activities, groups)
- Case work including 1-1 support (emotional, educational, family)
- Referral to external services for children and adults where appropriate
- Art and Play Therapy
- Referral to external providers for respite and therapeutic services
- Young Adult Carers Service for young carers aged over 18

"Without the Young Carers Service I would never have been able to sort out my education and wouldn't be where I am today." Young carers play a special role in caring for others, but that often means you have to grow up fast!
Caring for someone can sometimes leave you feeling stressed, tired and alone, with little time for yourself and lots of responsibilities.

It is really important that you're able to enjoy yourself and feel a sense of achievement in all that you do. We are here to support you whilst you make a positive contribution to the lives of others.
